School Uniform


Our uniform is designed to help promote our high expectations and high standards. It helps to ensure all of our students aspire to achieve excellence.

Blazers and ties are only available from our uniform supplier. They also provide other uniform items that meet our school expectations. If you are buying from any other shops, check the uniform booklet that we will send to you soon. We always want you looking your best!

Not Allowed

- Polo or fashion shirts.
- Extremes of hair styles or hair dyed an unnatural colour.
- Makeup and jewellery must be kept to a minimum, with no visible facial piercings.
- Tight fitting trousers or skirts. Skirts must not be tight or in a stretchy fabric.
- Leggings/skinny legged trousers, jeans/jean styles/jean style back pockets, zip pockets, trousers with rivets or visible fashion labels etc.
- Long boots, Uggs, trainers/trainer style and pumps
- Shoes should not have coloured logos or other coloured details. Black means completely black. Only eyelets can be metallic.

Your grey school blazer must not be removed unless given permission by a teacher. On very hot days, the SLT may allow blazers to be taken off all day but blazers must be brought to school.
