



**CURRICULUM INTENT:** The intent for our Ethics curriculum is that it is accessible to all and will maximise the outcomes for every student enabling them to become healthy, independent and responsible members of society. The Ethics curriculum **should result in the acquisition of knowledge and skills which enables our students to access the wider curriculum and to prepare them to be global citizens now and in their future roles within a global community.** The Ethics curriculum should also enable all students to be safe and to understand and develop healthy relationships both now and in their future lives.

The lessons bring together Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education. Emotional Wellbeing, Social Skills, Careers Information and Guidance, British Values, Relationship and Sex Education are all taught in a safe, empathic environment with particular emphasis on personal safety and safeguarding paramount at all times. We intend to help our students to understand how they are developing personally and socially, and tackle many of the moral, social and cultural issues that are part of growing up. We provide our students with opportunities for them to learn about rights and responsibilities and appreciate what it means to be a member of a diverse society. Our students are encouraged to develop their sense of self-worth by playing a positive role in contributing to school life and the wider community.
