Abstract



Something unusual that stands

Story telling



Performance where the actors tell a story to the audience in order.

String of material



A set of moves that follow one another, these are created by the actor and can be re-arranged

out. Fluid



Movements that follow one another easily, creatively and without errors.

Target audience



A set of people who a performance is aimed at

Narrator



A person who tells the story to the audience at the front of the stage
